Wedding Ceremony FAQs

Q: Should we talk?

A: Yes! The relationship with your wedding officiant is like the groom's tux — it has to be a great fit. So, we'll start with a quick phone or Zoom call to get to know each other. If you're comfortable, we can begin discussing some of the ceremony details. There's never a charge and never any obligation at this point.

Q: What happens next?

A: If it feels like a good fit, we can proceed to a ceremony planning session where we generate ideas and begin designing the overall flow of your wedding celebration. I'll then provide you with a draft, based on your input. This draft will cover all the bases — everything from introduction of the bride to exchange of rings and "I Dos." Most couples prefer to write their own vows, but I'm always here to help.

Q: What are the "3 Ps?"

A: Ultimately, you want a wedding officiant who is Professional, Personable and Punctual. Professional, because you want a gifted communicator helping you craft the perfect ceremony. Personable, because you want someone who can bring your ceremony to life with light-hearted moments and deeply felt emotion. And finally, Punctual, because you never want to be left wondering whether your officiant is going to show up!

Q: How far in advance should we book?

A: My calendar fills quickly, especially during the peak months of September – November. A year out is not too far to book. Although I always try to accommodate those "We've decided to elope this weekend" requests!

Do you require a deposit?

A: To make sure that everyone has some skin in the game, I ask for a modest deposit, typically \$100. Is it refundable? Almost always. I'm not one to rain on anyone's parade.

What locations do you cover?

A: To keep things simple, I've designed pricing to include travel to these nearby North Georgia/North Carolina/Tennessee towns:

Hiawassee

Ellijay

Young Harris

Blairsville

Copperhill, TN

Dahlonega

Murphy, NC

I do routinely travel out of the area (Atlanta, Western Georgia, Western Tennessee), but a trip to these areas typically adds \$100 to the total cost.

Q: Do you attend rehearsals?

A: The honest truth is that you don't need me hanging around your rehearsal. Rehearsals are for practicing how the wedding party will walk in and walk out, and where they will stand. They are typically handled by your venue or wedding planner, so no need to duplicate expenses (you're better off spending the money on an extra-decadent dessert for the reception!). If need be, we can do a same-day rehearsal an hour prior to the ceremony, which is typically when I would arrive.
